This is important information on changes in your ATRIO Choice Rx (PPO) coverage.

We previously let you know that your 2024 Evidence of Coverage (EOC) is available on our website or that you can call us to ask for a copy. Your EOC provides information about your coverage as an enrollee in our plan. This notice is to let you know there was an error in your EOC. Below you will find information describing and correcting the error. Please keep this information for your reference. On page 7, Chapter 1, Section 2.2 “ <i>Here is the plan service area for ATRIO Choice Rx (PPO)</i> ”, your EOC lists the service area as these counties in Oregon:	“Douglas County”	“Marion and Polk Counties”	No changes to this plan or coverage (this is only to correct the service area county name)
On page 108, Chapter 4, Section 3.1 “ <i>Services we do not cover (exclusions)</i> ”, under service “ <i>Naturopath services (uses natural or alternative treatments)</i> ”, your EOC states:	“Not covered under any condition”	Removal of Naturopath services from this list of excluded services	Naturopathy visits are covered by this plan in 2024 (see section 2.1 above under “Alternative (Naturopathy) Therapy Services (Non-Medicare covered)”)”))
