Paying Your Plan Premium

If we determine that you owe a late enrollment penalty (or if you currently have a late enrollment penalty), we need to know how you would prefer to pay it. You can pay by mail, Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) or credit card each month. You can also choose to pay your premium by automatic deduction from your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefit check each month. If you are assessed a Part D-Income related Monthly Adjustment Amount, you will be notified by the Social Security Administration. You will be responsible for paying this extra amount in addition to your plan premium. You will either have the amount withheld from your Social Security benefit check or be billed directly by Medicare or the RRB. **DO NOT pay ATRIO Health Plans the Part D-IRMAA.**

You can pay your monthly plan premium (including any late enrollment penalty that you currently have or may owe) by mail, “Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)”, or “credit card” each month. You can also choose to pay your premium by automatic deduction from your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefit check each month.

If you are assessed a Part D-Income Related Monthly Adjustment Amount, you will be notified by the Social Security Administration. You will be responsible for paying this extra amount in addition to your plan premium. You will either have the amount withheld from your Social Security benefit check or be billed directly by Medicare or RRB. DO NOT pay ATRIO Health Plans the Part D-IRMAA.

People with limited incomes may qualify for Extra Help to pay for their prescription drug costs. If eligible, Medicare could pay for 75% or more of your drug costs including monthly prescription drug premiums, annual deductibles, and co-insurance. Additionally, those who qualify will not be subject to the coverage gap or a late enrollment penalty. Many people are eligible for these savings and don't even know it. You can also apply for Extra Help online at www.socialsecurity.gov/prescriptionhelp.

If you qualify for Extra Help with your Medicare prescription drug coverage costs, Medicare will pay all or part of your plan premium. If Medicare pays only a portion of this premium, we will bill you for the amount that Medicare doesn't cover.

If Social Security or RRB does not approve your request for automatic deduction, we will send you a paper bill for your monthly premiums.)

By completing this enrollment application, I agree to the following:

ATRIO Health Plans has PPO and HMO D-SNP plans with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in ATRIO Health Plans depends on contract renewal. I will need to keep my Medicare Parts A and B. I can be in only one Medicare Advantage plan at a time, and I understand that my enrollment in this plan will automatically end my enrollment in another Medicare Health plan or prescription drug plan. It is my responsibility to inform you of any prescription drug coverage that I have or may get in the future. I understand that if I don't have Medicare prescription drug coverage, or creditable prescription drug coverage (as good as Medicare's), I may have to pay a late enrollment

penalty if I enroll in Medicare prescription drug coverage in the future. Enrollment in this plan is generally for the entire year. Once I enroll, I may leave this plan or make changes only at certain times of the year when an enrollment period is available (Example: October 15 – December 7 of every year), or under certain special circumstances.

ATRIO Health Plans serves a specific service area. If I move out of the area that ATRIO Health Plans serves, I need to notify the plan so I can disenroll and find a new plan in my new area. Once I am a member of ATRIO Health Plans, I have the right to appeal plan decisions about payment or services if I disagree. I will read the Evidence of Coverage document from ATRIO Health Plans when I get it to know which rules I must follow to get coverage with this Medicare Advantage plan. I understand that people with Medicare aren't usually covered under Medicare while out of the country except for limited coverage near the U.S. border.

I understand that beginning on the date ATRIO Health Plans coverage begins, using services in-network can cost less than using services out-of-network, except for emergency or urgently needed services or out-of-area dialysis services. If medically necessary, ATRIO Health Plans provides refunds for all covered benefits, even if I get services out of network. Services authorized by ATRIO Health Plans and other services contained in my ATRIO Health Plans Evidence of Coverage document (also known as a member contract or subscriber agreement) will be covered. Without authorization, **NEITHER MEDICARE NOR ATRIO HEALTH PLANS WILL PAY FOR THE SERVICES.**

I understand that if I am getting assistance from a sales agent, broker, or other individual employed by or contracted with ATRIO Health Plans, he/she may be paid based on my enrollment in ATRIO Health Plans.

Release of Information: By joining this Medicare health plan, I acknowledge that ATRIO Health Plans will release my information to Medicare and other plans as is necessary for treatment, payment and health care operations. I also acknowledge that ATRIO Health Plans will release my information including my prescription drug event data to Medicare, who may release it for research and other purposes which follow all applicable Federal statutes and regulations. The information on this enrollment form is correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that if I intentionally provide false information on this form, I will be disenrolled from the plan.
